Greetings, COLE FAMILY!

Plans are under way for our **annual Cole Family Reunion on Sunday, August 9, 2015 in Boonville, Missouri.** For **81 years** the descendants of Hannah Allison Cole have gathered together in Missouri. Where do you gather with Cole relatives? Hannah's descendants have been here to Hannah's home town to visit and tell us about reunions in Texas and California. Where do you and other Cole descendents meet for a Cole reunion? Let us know! Perhaps we could visit your reunion and then perhaps you could visit Hannah's home town. We would love to see you and to hear from you!

On the **Saturday evening, August 8,** we will gather at Hannah's statue in the Morgan Street Park, Boonville at 5:15 – 5:30 p.m. We will continue on to a local restaurant to eat and visit. There will be a sign posted on Hannah's statue to tell you the restaurant if you are late. Come and join us!

As you make your **preparations for coming to the reunion**, consider spending the weekend in the area. Here are several suggestions for places to stay while you are in Boonville: Hotel Frederick, 888-437-2231; Isle of Capri Casino Hotel, 800-941-4753; Holiday Inn Express, 660-882-6882; and Comfort Inn, 660-882-5317. Also nearby Columbia has accommodations as well as Rocheport with bed and breakfast facilities available. There are area attractions such as the Friends of Historic Boonville museum (in the Old Jail) with our Cole history items; Katy Trail State Park; Isle of Capri Casino; Warm Springs Ranch, home of the Budweiser Clydesdales (will be booked at least two weeks ahead so make your reservations early); Les Bourgeois Vineyards; Briscoe Cemetery, where Hannah is buried; Arrow Rock Lyceum Theatre to name a few! You can research the area on the internet. If access is an issue, please go to your local public library where access is available.

The Cole Family lost an important person to our family history in May. Arthur Schneider was the primary person responsible for a Hannah Cole statue being erected in Boonville. Carolyn Eichelberger worked on the committee that Art formed and can tell you about the several years and many, many hours of work that went into this endeavor. Funds were solicited and raised from far and wide. Sculptors were contacted and one selected. Plans for the park and statue were drawn and reviewed. The dedication ceremony was held June 6, 2004. Many, many thanks for his dedication, perseverance and foresight for this endeavor! We hereby declare that Arthur Schneider is an honorary Cole Family member posthumously. The cemetery requires continual maintenance. It is possible that dirt will need to be hauled in to make the ground level again. There are still three dead trees standing which will require removal at some point. These are some of the reasons for the cemetery fund and for our continual solicitation of funds for maintenance.

Friends of Historic Boonville: The Friends keep the archives and mementoes of the family and try to work with us to be open when we have the reunion or something special. They take time to put out a special display of Cole Family mementoes the weekend of our reunion; otherwise the family history information is kept as a private collection.
